Opening event. 1st National Forum of the new collective sustainable mobility: reforms and investments

Language: Italian

The ISFORT research (of which the "discussion paper" is the summary and starting point for the debate) aims to take stock of the current and prospective position on Sustainable Local Mobility, providing a dashboard of aggregate data useful for probing its three main axes (the market, supporting policies and evolutionary scenarios), along with a series of stimuli useful for answering key questions emerging from the industry and related new supply chains.

Market. What is the market "trend" today and what are the prospects for post-emergency? This question will be attempted to be answered thanks also to some anticipation of the new data from Isfort's "Audimob" Observatory on citizen mobility (consolidated 2021, first 2022 data and forecast scenarios).

National support policies. The "discussion paper" will contain an updated summary overview of the resources available to collective mobility and the industrial bus supply chain, starting with the NRP, with a focus on any emerging critical operational issues.

Evolution scenarios. Finally, the "paper" aims to broaden the look at future scenarios for public transport by offering insights into new development "drivers" and outcomes on markets and business models, just think of the MaaS (Mobility-as-a-Service) paradigm.

Driver profession: license bonus, young drivers, new scenarios, new perspectives between safety and innovation to drive the future

The socio-economic and technological context we are experiencing is affected by evolutionary trends that are declining with great rapidity and that impose increasing flexibility in personal services and in the approach to professions and trades. At the same time, the process of energy and digital conversion of the entire production imposes a greater and more relevant technical and humanistic education capable of providing the tools to govern technology. The profession of the driver, which in these last two pandemic years has rediscovered its central role in societies, is on the threshold of its own transformation. MaaS, with its flexibilization of service, the transformation of vehicle fleets that are becoming increasingly complex, and self-driving vehicles, will require driver operators who are increasingly specialized and capable of managing increasingly articulated, interconnected and complex transportation systems. The conference offers national testimony on the need for new training for European professional drivers. ADAS technologies will be explained and light will be shed on the distinction between skills and knowledges, also taking into consideration "vulnerable road users." The objective of the event is to offer means and answers to meet the new challenges that the EU requires in Vision Zero, but also to highlight the job opportunities that today's new conscious mobility offers future drivers in addition to the driver's license bonus, included in the Milleproroghe decree, which consists of a reimbursement equal to 80 percent of the expenses incurred to obtain the license and professional driving qualification.

The current state does not allow Tourist Buses to access 100% electric, due to lack of the necessary technology (batteries supporting long and very long distance). The sector-which is already coming out of two years of heavy crisis due to Covid and now also suffering the consequences of the ongoing war in Ukraine-must necessarily be supported in order to be competitive in the renewal effort towards the greenest vehicles currently available, namely Euro 6, which have a near-zero environmental impact. Moreover, at this stage, our companies should enjoy reduced rates pending access to vehicles with alternative engines to diesel. Add to this the fact that the European Council's proposal for a directive restructuring the Union framework for the taxation of energy products and electricity (recast) COM/2021/563 will in fact already result in an increase in the cost of diesel used as fuel by our vehicles from 2023. Finally, it will be essential to bridge the employment gap between supply and demand for new professionals for a sector that must aim, like all tourism, to have people who are prepared and trained to meet the challenge of a country that aspires to be a leader in the tourism sector worldwide.

The strategic role of data in the development and modernization of public transport and sustainable local mobility

The centrality of data for the proper setting of local public transport policies in its articulated procedural stages has long been one of the key issues at the attention of public decision makers. In the evolution of local mobility systems, looking at both new demand needs and new supply architectures, more flexible innovative services that complement the traditional scheduled LPT and are integrated into a broader, more flexible and more adherent to citizens' needs assume centrality. Moreover, broadening our gaze to local mobility policies, we cannot fail to mention the role played by planning, and in particular by Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans. The need for statistical information thus expands to the analysis and monitoring of new services and planning processes. Starting from a methodological and operational in-depth work on the topic, started a few months ago by federMobility with the support of Isfort, the workshop intends to discuss with the stakeholders of the system some first results achieved by the research activity, gathering points of view and reflections from different angles of observation and work.

MaaS in villages: new solutions and opportunities

MaaS is an acronym that stands for Mobility as a Service, referring to an organizational model of transportation capable of combining efficiency, technological development and environmental sustainability. Realizing, thanks to digital technology, a new way of getting around, moving from private mobility carried out using one's own vehicle (predominant today, especially in the boroughs) to shared mobility, implemented by employing the various public and private means available, depending on one's needs at the time. It therefore provides for the integration of a multiplicity of services that become accessible from "digital intermediary platforms" that also provide different functionalities (information, trip planning and booking, unified payment for services, post-trip operations) thanks to which the user receives personalized answers to his or her mobility needs. The challenge is to decline MaaS in the context of "the boroughs," areas that are less urbanized and underserved than cities, highlighting criticalities and opportunities with real examples, stimulating and experimenting with new solutions, targeting possible and versatile standardizations: intermodality, sustainability and affordability serving the Boroughs.

Consip-a joint-stock company wholly owned by the Ministry of Economy and Finance-operates at the exclusive service of the public administration with the aim of making the use of public resources more efficient and transparent, providing administrations with tools to manage their purchases, stimulating companies to compete, and rationalizing public spending. Among the various areas of intervention, of particular importance is the automotive sector and in particular initiatives for public mobility, offering contracts for the purchase of buses for local public transport. In recent years, several tools have been pursued in the area of sustainable mobility: from the Framework Agreements on suburban buses and urban buses (in which there is a substantial supply of vehicles with low environmental impact) to the Framework Agreement Methane Buses, which makes available more than vehicles that can be purchased using resources from the Complementary Fund to the PNRR earmarked for the purchase of buses used for suburban and suburban public transport (Ministerial Decree on Sustainable Infrastructure and Mobility No. 315 of 02/08/2021), and the upcoming initiatives on electric-powered vehicles.
